- Free shuttle buses between the BWI train station and the BWI Airport terminals operate every 12-25 minutes daily. Buses stop adjacent to the rail station garage directly across from the station building.
- Receive automatic gate and track notifications on your phone when departing from BWI Airport. Download the app from Amtrak.com/mobile and enable "Trip Updates & Status" in the settings.
- The boarding gate at Washington Union Station closes two minutes prior to train departure time.
- eTickets for Reserved services are valid only for the specific train number, date and accommodation type booked.
- You have a reserved seat in Acela Business class. To view or change your seat location, retrieve your reservation on Amtrak.com or in the Amtrak app. Be sure to reprint your eTicket if you change your seat. For more information about reserved seating, visit Amtrak.com/reserved-seating.

- Passengers are encouraged to arrive at the station 30 minutes before departure or 60 minutes if in need of ticketing and/or baggage assistance, or if you're boarding at a Canadian station.
